The target of the DSD program is to achieve **DSD I (A2/B1) in Year 9 or 10** and **DSD II (B2/C1) in Year 11 or 12**. The exam is accredited to German programs in schools worldwide. It consists of four components that relate to the **four skills: read, write, speak and hear**. The test must be passed in every part, to obtain the DSD certification.

We require motivation, commitment, self discipline and hard work. Extra work is required even during the holidays for higher classes, in order to be fully prepared for the DSD exams.
